We prepare students, educators, and working professionals for better disagreements.


Argument Mapping

Argument Mapping illuminates disagreements, uncovering assumptions, logical errors, and weak evidence as well as points of connection.

Systematic Empathy

Slows down thinking and redrafts disagreements in real time. Through Systematic Empathy, opponents understand the thinking behind each other's views.

Logic and Empathy make even the most contentious disagreements grounds for one-on-one curiosity.

The 2022-2023 academic year was focused on development, moving our core product *How We Argue* from beta phase to a fullyfledged and refined product that teaches both **argument mapping** and **systematic empathy**.






